

What is Aspektism for Kids?

It is designed for the general public to gain insight of how Asperger's Syndrome affects the lives of those individuals who have the disorder. It is targeted at parents/carers/society to gain greater understanding of the disorder, and is aimed at children (years 5 – 12) on the Autism Spectrum.

Kerryn had absolutely no idea what to do as a child, because she didn't have a name for her problem. She simply couldn't do things like make friends, as she didn't know how to, along with playing games as she went along with what other people did, not making decisions on her own.

Throughout her life journey she changed from a child's life perspective into the mature adult woman she is now. During this time, she learnt to make decisions/choices on her own by listening to her own gut intuition. She also learnt to make friends through attending church weekly & keeping/maintaining those friendships she has now, still remain today.

It was re-develop this course aimed at children to assist society of what it is like

to live with such a disorder, from a child's perspective.

What made you decide that an Asperger's course for children was necessary?

There was a need from parents to both assist & help their children learn/grow/develop and to learn new skills associated with Autism/Asperger's Syndrome. Therefore the course was developed to assist in this area.

Are there other Autism related courses on the market?

There are other Autism related courses targeted at children on the market, at present but none written from a person's real life perspective.

What course modules are there in Aspektism for Kids?

Bullyism, Sensism, Socialism & Choiceism. Please Note: The first 4 existing modules from the Aspektism for Adults course has been modified to fit in, and run with this course if requested.

Do you have more information on these modules?

With the first module, **Asperism**, you learn more about Asperger's Syndrome, and the features of it.

bullyism: Learn how kids with ASD/AS are bullied in school/society and how to deal with it.

Sensism: How to teach your child with ASD/AS about their feelings and strategies to learn how to recognize them.

Socialism: How to teach your child with ASD/AS social/communicative skills and discusses favorite obsessions and how to deal with them effectively.

Choiceism: It also discusses decision making and how to learn how to make their choices/decisions for life.
